

How to Extend the Learning from Theodore Elliot Bear Transforms into a Beaver video

- Read about beavers.
- Visit the website of Beavers Northwest.
- Using water running from a hose to create a small stream use sticks, mud, and small stones to dam it. Observe what happens.
- Freeze a banana on a stick and try to cut it down by gnawing it with just your front teeth
- Discover which other animals have a nictating membrane/third eyelid.
- Choose another animal and write a script transforming Ted E. Bear into that animal. If you submit your script to us we just might use it to transform Ted E. Bear into something else.
- Beavers have special oils in their coat that make them water proof. Experiment with different cooking oils on your hands. Do any of them make water bead up on your skin?
- Visit a site with beavers and look for signs of beaver activity.
- Make a list of animals that benefit from beaver activity
- Discover which animal family beavers belong to and what they all have in common.
- Make your own video about an animal.
- Dress yourself up as a beaver.
